We are looking forward to seeing you at the 33rd Annual Tennessee State Youth Conference, to be held in Gatlinburg, Tennessee, on April 23-25, 2010. The theme for this year will be **“Are You Drifting or Anchored With Christ?”**

Enclosed you will find important information and forms to be completed by each person attending the conference. These documents may be duplicated as necessary to accommodate the needs of your congregation. Registration is not complete until we have received payment in full, completed registration forms for each attendee, group lodging forms, counselor acknowledgement forms, and contestant registration and acknowledgement of rules form for any pageant participants. Registration **must be postmarked by March 1, 2010 to avoid a late registration fee of \$25 per person registered after this date. There will be no exceptions.** Payment is due upon registration by church check, cashier's check or money order. No personal checks will be accepted in the mail or onsite at the conference.

It is very important for at least one representative from each congregation to attend a counselor's meeting on Friday, April 23 at 6 PM to review the conference rules and logistics. Please remember, the conference rules should also be reviewed with each attendee before arrival.

Please keep in mind that all youth must be under the supervision of a counselor or parent at all times (1 male counselor to 3 male youth; 1 female counselor to 3 female youth). **Modesty is very important; therefore, the dress code will be strictly enforced.** Attendees 6 years of age and older must pay full registration. Meal tickets may be purchased for children ages 2-5. Registration forms and payment must be submitted for bus drivers along with all other registrants if the driver will reside at the hotel. **Check-in will begin at 4 PM at the Park Vista Resort, 705 Cherokee Orchard Road, Gatlinburg, TN.**
